

GENERAL INFORMATION

RESIDENCE

Course members will reside at the Staverton Park Conference Centre and should arrive by 5.00pm on Sunday 11 October 2009. Please note that the Course Opening and Welcoming will be at 7.30pm. If personal circumstances make this impossible, please advise The Refereeing Department at The Football Association immediately.

The Staverton Park Conference Centre is situated near Daventry in Northamptonshire. All rooms are en suite for single occupancy and have tea/coffee making facilities as well as a desk and colour television with sky channels. There are also 13 amp sockets and a shaver point in each bedroom as well as an alarm clock / radio. There is also a direct dialling facility which allows you to receive phone calls direct to your bedroom. Please note that International Dialling from the Conference Centre is very expensive. There is also a pay phone nearby if you wish to use one.

FIRE EVACUATION PROCEDURES

On hearing a continuous firm alarm siren, please make your way to the Car Park at the front of the building and report to your Group Instructor. Fire exits are clearly marked. SMOKING

The Centre regulations regarding smoking must be followed at all times. Staverton Park (indoors) is a strictly 'No Smoking' venue. Smoking is not permitted in the building at any time.

FIRST AID

Staverton Park has a number of qualified First Aid Personnel on duty 24 hours. Please contact Reception if you require any assistance.

LEISURE FACILITIES

Staverton Park is set in beautiful countryside in middle England and offers numerous leisure facilities including gymnasium, swimming pool and a 18 hole golf course. For those who prefer more gentle exercise our landscaped grounds is the perfect setting for a leisurely stroll.

Facilities also include football pitches in the village of Staverton some 10 minutes walk from the centre. The gymnasium is open from 6am until 10pm and boasts excellent cardiovascular and weight training equipment, it also has its own male and female changing room facilities.

Breaks: There are refreshment stations at various locations around the Centre and your Group Instructor will make the necessary arrangements for you to take advantage of these at appropriate times in the programme.

Meals will generally be served in the main dining room but there may be changes from time to time during the week and your Group Instructor will keep you informed of these as and when they happen.

DRESS CODE

International guests are invited to wear their National Dress or lounge suite and tie for the end of Course Dinner on Saturday 17th October 2009. At all other times on the course, shirts, plain polo shirts and tracksuit bottoms or trousers can be worn. It is recommended that you bring with you suitable attire for participation in outdoor sessions (tracksuits, shorts and suitable footwear/football boots and appropriate rainwear).

TEACHING AIDS
